3.		Tanks: Type (UL #), size, gallons, type of fuel or other hazardous materials contained. Venting installation on the tank.
4.		Foundation Details Tank support Containment including walls/footing Other slabs/footings Water seals Sumps, etc. (if allowed by NDEP) Indicate tank anchorage system Wet stamped by Nevada engineer
5.		MSDS on hazardous materials
6.		Fire hydrant location, gpm & psi
7.		Indicate contractor and subcontractors
8.		Contractor signs all plans with contractors number
9.		Spill control/overfill protection location, type, size
10.		Containment design criteria/size
11.		Specifications on all equipment, hoses, nozzles, piping, dispensers, break aways, valves antisphion, pumps, and leak detection.
12.		Indicate location of supply lines & size if applicable
13.		Indicate location of emergency disconnect & label.
14.		Location, size, type of portable fire extinguishers
15.		Submit electrical drawing indicating location of all hazardous location devices (seal offs), fixtures, subpanel, service, etc.
16.		Indicate guard post location & type
17.		Indicate stairs or platforms, walkways, etc. if application. These structures may require to be stamped by a Nevada engineer.

Plan reviews and fire code reviews may take up to two weeks once a <u>complete</u> set of plans is submitted.
