## REQUIREMENTS FOR APPLYING FOR TEMPORARY ELECTRIC/GAS SERVICE

All services for residential or commercial buildings or structures are considered temporary until a final inspection is approved by the building department.

Temporary services are approved under the following conditions:

- 1. For a period not to exceed 30 days unless approved by the Building Official (Extensions may be applied for in writing and must be approved by the Building Official). Site built homes and buildings with the required permit issued will automatically be extended thru the construction (permits shall be valid per normal code requirements)
- 2. The utility company is notified of the temporary nature of the approval and if violated will be directed to disconnect the utility. Request for disconnection will be writing and the owner will also be informed in writing.
- 3. The installation shall comply with the most current codes adopted. (NEC, UPC, IRC, UMC).
- 4. If the service is a permanent service size the service adequate for all current and future power needs (Only service is permitted on the parcel or bldg)
- 5. A GFCI outlet in a weathertight box shall be placed on the service pole & connected to the properly sized breaker in the meter panel.
