TEMPORARY SERVICES POLICY STATEMENT

APPLICANTS FOR TEMPORARY SERVICES:

- a. SIGN THE TEMPORARY SERVICES AGREEMENT TO:
 - 1. NOT OCCUPY THE STRUCTURE
 - 2. OBSERVE ALL SAFETY REGULATIONS
 - 3. COMPLY WITH ALL TEMPORARY ELECTRIC/GAS REQUIREMENTS
- b. STATE ON THE APPLICATION PRECISELY WHAT THE TEMPORARY SERVICE IS TO BE USED FOR. TEMPORARY SERVICES IS LIMITED TO THE FOLLOWING:
 - 1. DURING A PERIOD OF CONSTRUCTION (Current adopted National Electric Code & Uniform Plumbing Code)

Temporary services are approved under the following conditions:

- For a period of not to exceed 30 days unless approved by the Building Official (Extensions may be applied for in writing and must be approved by the Building Official). Site built homes, buildings, and manufactured homes with a valid permit issued will automatically be extended thru the construction.
- 2. The utility company is notified of the temporary nature of the approval and if violated will be directed to disconnect the utility. Request for disconnection will be in writing and the owner will also be informed in writing.
- 3. The installation shall comply with the most current codes adopted.
- 4. If the service is permanent size the service adequately for all current and future power needs. Only one service is permitted on a parcel or building.

All services for residential or commercial buildings or structures are consider temporary until a final inspection is approved by the building department and a septic/well installation is approved by a state agency.
